- The rodent problem seems to have now abated. Position has been placed in the sewers and the fields.
- Site personnel parking on the pavement has been reported to the Site Manager.
- Cllr. Payne has been in contact with the Malvern Homes Site Manager and updated him on all the issues with regards travellers entering the site. They were unaware of the situation and have employed enhanced security.
