- 4.2 Cllr. Nock August council creases with very little activity. Although he was one of five members of the Governance Task Group of which he is Vice Chairman. The Group have meet virtually during August to consider alternative governance structures. These range from a Committee System all the way through to a Mayoral System at the other end of the spectrum, with alternative hybrid models in between. The Committee System would involve all members in the legal act of decision making, whereas a Mayoral System may involve only one person. A recommendation will be made to Cabinet in September and brought to Full Council.

5.1 Cllr. May – plans for a puffin crossing at St Kenelms School is going forward with Section 106 money from the Bluebird development. It is due to be ratified in October 2023 and implemented Summer 2024. The proposal will include streetlighting on both approaches.
