4.2 Cllr. Nock: -

- Been out Cllr. May and consultants to look at parking hotspots. Although there are none in Hunnington there are issues with parking outside St Kenelms School and the Co-Op in Romsley. District have brought consultants in due to the lack of parking enforcement within the district. Parish councillors did confirm that there are parking issues in Hunnington at the Cricket Club and when the car-boot sale is on. Cllr. Nock confirmed these areas would be reported to the Enforcement Officer for them to take a look.
- 2020/21 accounts are now ready to be filed with the rest being filed every two months thereafter.

5. COUNTY COUNCILLOR

5.1 Cllr. May: -

- The pedex school crossing is through and will have four lighting columns shining down from properties in the vicinity and will be lit from 7.00m to 1030pm.
- Cadent gas works are continuing and are reporting status on a weekly basis.

- Drainage at the Bluebird site has been reported to Worcestershire Water Management.
- KP confirmed that the bus stop outside the Bluebird has still to be reinstalled.
- KP confirmed there is stagnant water outside the Bluebird site and Cllr. May agreed to arrange a meeting with Bellway and parish council representatives to look at our concerns.
- Starting next year's budgeting process.
- County Hall has been closed due to legionnaire in the water system, so all staff are currently working from home.
